Père Félix, after thanking the Red Cross Knights, complimented the new Archbishop, and counting the entire audience as patriots and Christians, developed for one hour and a half the theoretical safety required, and the practical application of suffering came from sin, disaster from disorder, misfortune from evil. It is egotism detaches man from God. Since 6000 years human suffering has existed to alleviate human pain. He ransacked ancient history to illustrate this, and concluded the annals of France alone suffered. France did not perish after the execution of Louis XVI., of Joan of Arc, or of Archbishop Alys. The manner received several nostalgic knocks; but his allusion to the martyrdom of Monsiegnor Darboy was more logical and telling. He recounted the late campaign; but one felt he was moved at home in his appeal for help for its victims, which was well responded to by 75,000 francs.

The Princess Marguerite of Orleans has been well married, not only by her union with Prince Czartorski of the royal house of Poland—four counts as plain as the daughter of Bourbon— in a training suit, dress, trimmed with orange flowers, and not much tulle or lace. Her grace, beauty and innocence were sufficient. The Polish ceremony consisted in conducting the happy couple to their nuptial chamber and blessing the couch. The bridegroom was then presented with a loaf having a hole therein filled with salt. He in turn offered it to his bride, the bread was an emblem of sanctity, salt of preservation; but as neither article could last for a long period, a Polish diadem in gold was added, with the image of the Virgin, which the wife is never to part with. After these ceremonies the bride appeared in all her wardrobe, including a jeweller's shop. The archbishop died yesterday at the Hôtel Lambert, where, under the watchful eye of his predecessor, he spent his last hours. He remained for a quarter of an hour alone in prayer—Calvary truly before his eyes. It may be generally known that Mgr. Darboy after being transferred to this prison, passed his first four hours in the "Tropmann cell."

LATEST FROM VENEZUELA.

The following are the latest advices from Venezuela. To the general reader there will, doubtless, appear a great similarity between the Banda Oriental and the State of Venezuela. Maracibo. The indications are that affairs here are approaching a crisis. Guzman Blanco is still at Valencia with his troops. He has a good army, and plenty of arms and ammunition. It is generally supposed that he means fight, but his course generally indicates that he is by no means certain of success. A counter-revolution is against here, and the forces which promises to be formidable. Pulgar is now at Quipillo, meeting with great success. In his absence General Arango carries on the government. Two German gunboats have been ordered here from Kiel for the protection of the German residents. They are expected shortly. Owing to the blocading of the ports of the interior, Pulgar's forward commerce stagnated. Coffee is scarcely to be had, and fabulous prices are being paid for it. Innocencio Hernandez, late Governor of Maracibo, is still imprisoned at the castle, where he is treated with great indignity and kept in irons. He has paid \$6,000 of the \$10,000 he agreed to pay for his release, but has not yet been able to raise the balance. He, while he is closely guarded; even his soup and food is carefully searched for any communications which it is thought may be made to him. Guzman Blanco has lodged \$300,000 in his own credit at the bank at Port of Spain, and he is trying to raise a loan, so that if circumstances render it necessary he can leave for Paris or elsewhere with about a million. Old and young men, regardless of age, are seized on the streets and compelled to serve as soldiers. NOTICE TO GAS COMPANIES.

The Gas Companies of Buenos Ayres would do well to study the following account of a terrible gas explosion which has recently occurred in New York; but for the presence of mind of one of the employees, the accident might have led to an appalling catastrophe; such an accident might occur here, therefore to be forewarned is to be forearmed. Saturday evening the purifying house at the Metropolitan Gas works exploded, and though many means were taken to prevent it, it caused a panic in the neighborhood and great inconvenience to the people in that part of the City. The building in which the accident occurred was blown into a complete wreck. Those who saw and heard the explosion say that the noise was like that supposed to be made by an earthquake. Houses were shaken in the neighborhood, and their inhabitants for a few minutes were lost in amazement. Immediately after the explosion the gas throughout the Company's district went out, and all was darkness. People living near the gas-works, became stricken with fear, and thought that some direful calamity was about to take place. In a short time, however, the exact state of affairs was ascertained, and everybody began to make the best of their darkened position by bringing out requisition lamps, long tapers, and candles bought at the neighboring groceries. As far as could be learned, no one was injured except those who were cut off by the gas from their homes. At this time, however, the severe character, and he was taken to Bellevue Hospital. The fire was extinguished about two hours after the explosion. A frightful calamity was averted by the presence of mind of one of the employees of the Company, who, shutting the gates leading with the gas from the houses. But for this precaution there might have been gas explosions all over the district. The gas-holders of the Company contained at the time of the explosion 12,000 cubic feet of gas, as was stated by one of the employees. Had fire communicated with the gas in the houses, frightful consequences would have been the result. This was also pre-

vented by the precautions immediately taken. When the accident was known, crowds rushed to the scene, but showed some timidity to make a close approach to the work, fearing another explosion. The Company, at a late hour, issued a notice to consumers, announcing that gas could not be furnished for three or four days.

EDITORIAL TABLE.

The ss. Tampa, of the Italo-Platense line, arrived at Montevideo on Monday; she brings European dates, from Gibraltar to the 31st ult. There is but little intelligence of interest from the Old World. M. Thiers has intimated his intention of attending the assembly only when matters of the first importance are being discussed, and that he will not be present for a time, in consideration of a permanent return to Paris. A reaction against carrying the unity movement any further is manifesting itself in the South German States. The new import duties in Spain have given rise to a bloody conflict between the military and the populace at Barcelona; several killed and wounded. Japan is going ahead like an over-driven train, she is forcing French officers to teach her sons how to fight, also bank notes for fiscal trade; and is having a "code civil" drawn up by the united wisdom of French and German lawyers. Commercial news much the same.

We received most cheering news from the camp yesterday morning. The rain has been general, and the least trace of an anticyclone from the south informs us that, during a long residence in the country, he never remembers such a trying time in the camp as during the past six weeks—another month's "seca" would have starved every animal in the South. The weather in town yesterday was charming to a degree, fresh and healthy.

We find in our English exchanges a rumour to the effect that Maria, the prime of tenors, is about to marry the sister of an English Duke. We opine that the report requires confirmation, but as unlikely things have happened. Attorneys and maidens of humble degree have jumped from the stage to the perage by the score, but analogous cases to that now rumored have not been frequent. Maria may be destined to a better fortune.

A Parana paper gives the number of oxen slaughtered by Lopez Jordán during the Entre Rios war as 132,000, or 20 animals to each of his gauchos in the field. Can anyone tell us how many cattle the commanders on both sides in the Banda Oriental have "sampled" since the revolution began?

Yesterday morning early, while the house party was viewing the patio at the Standard office he discovered a newly born infant in the "casaca" box. The house is now set in tenants of respectable families, the female members of which were out of their beds in a twinkling, in terrific excitement, all anxious to have a look at the abandoned child. The doctor and Juez de Paz were at once sent for; the former declared the "young one" to have been about 72 hours in this world of woe, and the latter offered one of the women in the house \$450 mps. per month to take care of it, but she declined the responsibility, and the infant was sent to the Foundling Hospital.

We received yesterday a letter from the supercargo of the brig "Montevideo," dated Rio Janeiro, 18th inst. The vessel contains serious charges against the Welsh colonists at Chuput. We decline to publish it in the absence of the writer. It can do no harm to anyone, however, to extract the following paragraph descriptive of the colony:—"There are about twenty mud huts along the banks of the river. The people were very destitute; some of them having tasted bread for failed months. Their crops having failed they lived mostly on dock leaves; most of them have cows which give milk, butter and cheese, but owing to their poverty they were not able to get seed, and in many cases were content to reap what was sown years before, and accidently seeded. The land they have is very good, also the horses. The Indians come to trade there twice a week, and bring horses which they sell cheap, but they again make raids and steal the best of them. The whole trade is carried on by barter, even to an egg. No money had been even seen by many for years before our arrival. Mr. Lewis Jones, the Alcaide, keeps a large stock of corn and manure, the largest of which is 25 feet by 9, and covered with reeds. Salt is very scarce and not to be had for 40 lbs. per sac; it is 100 lbs. per lb."

The fine Arts are raising their head in this country, at least painting is—witness Mr. 'Blanes' picture of the Plague, and the picture of the burning of the Americas by another Oriol. As usual, however, the Plague has been beaten by the Mississippi, and we find by our latest advices from the States that an artist there recently painted a Winter scene so true to Nature that a child which slept near it, was nearly frozen to death. Laro's final trial comes off on Wednesday, but we are not so sure that Justice will get her due notwithstanding that our colleague Don Luis Varela, is lending his talents to defend the prisoner. If Laro escape good may even come of it; it will give Lynch-law a chance of being established; "ce n'est que le premier pas qui coûte," and the hands of the populace once loosened will struggle with the furies in Plaza Victoria proved half-dozen times, we should have the same rapid disappearance of bloody crimes here as the execution of Dr. Felicezagui's murderers caused at Montevideo. Our foreign colleagues and any of the native papers willing to throw out some of their eldering rubbish and make room for something useful, need do good by copying the "News for Governor Castro" which appeared in this paper yesterday. Five hundred resolute emigrants here could show quite as good an example.

An affecting incident took place at the residence of a respectable native family in town, on Sunday, at the house of Belman, neither young or old, but of fascinating manners, had been lodging for about a month with the family (papa, mamma, and three or four marriageable daughters), and during his stay had won their united regard. Last week he was summoned away to the camp, and when the parting hour arrived his melancholy followed him and he left in the tear way. Our countryman, we regret to say, could not speak a word of Spanish; and the girls were equally ignorant of English, and after herculean efforts on both sides to convey a mutual idea of their borrowed feelings, wet handkerchiefs had to be again applied to as the only interpreters. One miserable country man looked at the sterner Father, but just as he was about to confess himself beaten a "happy thought" saved him

from so painful an admission. He rushed to his room, and before the astonished lady and her daughters had recovered their surprise, again stood before them with the last word of a Spanish proverb, "No puedo ir a la cárcel"; and with his pocket-handkerchief in his "punch hand," and this invaluable book in his left, he proceeded to read, line for line, every word under the heading of "leave taking." When he got to the last radius he and his kind bosses were drowned in tears, while the girls supplied smothered sobs unconsciously like what convulsive laughter causes.

The "governor" came in at the moment and attempted to give the British a parting embrace. No man born in any part of the three Kingdoms has ever yet tamely submitted to the repulsive operation of "being embraced by one of his own sex"—no, not even his father. Our friend dried his eyes at once, shook the "governor" warmly by the hand, bowed respectfully to the ladies, and walked calmly to the carriage waiting for him with the air of a man who had done his duty. "We never remember seeing the native papers so insufferably dull as yesterday morning. Cold dash or "old horse" conveys an idea of charming novelty compared to the Spanish papers yesterday morning. With the exception of some dreary leaders there was positively nothing new; all seemed to have copied their intelligence from some colleague of the previous day. We suppose the rain on Monday had something to do with it. One valiant contemporary made a desperate attempt to save the situation by commenting on the solemn appearance of Baron Cotejipe's countenance as H.E. emerged from the bureau of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, affirming that he gave the Brazilians a Minister a bit of his mind on the Chaco and Treaty questions. We think it much more likely that the Foreign Minister gave his distinguished visitor a bit of lunch. Diplomats never "carry their hearts upon their sleeves for days to peek at."

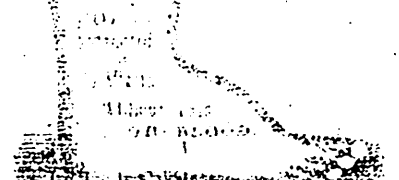
