IMPORTANT FROM CENTRAL AMERICA.

CANALS, RAILWAYS, IMMIGRATION.

CONFEDERACY OF THE FIVE REPUBLICS.

Panama, January 25th. From the Gaceta Oficial we learn that the Grand Congress of Central America had been called, and would meet this month at La Union.

The instructions given to the representative of Costa Rica refer to the following points—

1st. That the Constitution of the five republics should guarantee perfect equality of civil and political rights to all Central Americans.

2nd. The establishment of a line of telegraphs running through all the territory of Central America, and to be put in connection by a submarine cable with that of Colon.

3rd. That the creation of the codes and customs laws should be identical also in weights, measures, and coinage, the latter to be according to the decimal system, for all Central America.

4th. The convocation of a Congress of Plenipotentiaries for the above objects to dictate laws and codes.

5th. The establishment of steamers between Punta Arenas and Champerico, touching at all the intermediate ports.

6th. To provide the means of best avoiding disputes between the five republics, and in case of necessity, the three States should take the part of the State attacked.

7th. To determine that under no pretext whatever can any State sell or cede any part of its territory to any foreign government, the better to preserve intact the autonomy and integrity of Central America.

8th. The establishment of a railroad through all the States composing Central America.

9th. The construction of an interoceanic canal, to be called Spanish America.

Splendid and enthusiastic feasts had taken place at Alajuela on the 25th, 26th and 27th of last month, at which the President and the high dignitaries of the nation were present.

The proposed interview between the Presidents of Guatemala and Salvador, to treat of business of importance for both republics' welfare, says the Oropaisa of Guatemala of the 6th inst., will take place in a few days.

For the Conferences which are to take place in La Union, on the nationality of Central America, Don Antonio Cruz has been appointed to represent Guatemala.

The Coat of Arms of the Republic of Guatemala has been modified in accordance with the decree of 18th of Nov. last.

Father Guell, in search of a new locality for agricultural enterprises, has discovered in the Cordillera between the River Montañas and the River Polochic, an extensive territory with a cool healthy climate, suitable for every kind of cultivation.

The impression among the other Central American States about Costa Rica was, that notwithstanding the great benefits to be expected from the railroad, for the present there was a certain amount of alarm whether a deficiency of food would not be the consequence of the addition to the population, caused by the works on the railroad.

Don Delfino Sanchez had returned from the United States of America, bringing with him 1,000 rifles of Remington, a mill-train of 10 barrels blowing 700 balls a minute.

General Barrios has organized a force of 6,000 men, to be prepared to put down any reactionary movements that may be attempted.

A question of great National and State interest, says the Estrella de Casaca of the 30th December last, is now being discussed in the State of Casaca, owing to the arrival of Messrs. Smith and Moller, railroad engineers and contractors offering to build the road from Cali to Buenaventura, part rail and part carriage road.

The Gaceta says "in spite of the provocations of the Press of Salvador and Guatemala, which are in every way offensive and unjust towards the Government of Honduras, the latter is still content to remain pacific, and with no fears of a war between the two Republics.

The Centro-Americano of 2nd inst., in its review of the different States, says of Honduras, that disorders still continued there and that General Medina supported by the reactionary party, had yet been unable to suppress the insurrection of Curaran, though he believed himself quite strong enough to fight the Republic of Salvador.

Judging from the Porvenir, the treaty of Commerce between Nicaragua and Costa Rica does not seem to give satisfaction; the objection to it being that all the benefits are on the side of Costa Rica.
