Perhaps some of our readers may take it as a joke to propose making railways of flint and wood, or quabracho, but we should like to have the opinion of Mr. Wheelwright as to the feasibility of doing so.

When we bear in mind how largely the price of iron must enter into our estimates of future railways, how much reason there is to apprehend an Iron-famine or at least exorbitant rates in England, and how indispensable railways will be for this Republic in the next twenty years, it is neither chimerical nor uncalculated for to suggest that the Argentine Government adopt either or both of the expedients we have indicated:—

- 1st. To look for iron in the Provinces. 2nd. To try our hard wood as a substitute in making Railways.
