CENTRAL URUGUAY RAILWAY. INAUGURATION OF SANTA LUCIA BRIDGE.

On Tuesday morning at 9 o'clock a special train left Montevideo for Santa Lucia to test the bridge by running the first train over it.

Crossing the Miguelete we obtain a view of the quintas of Hughes, Castro, &c., behind which the woods and mill of Buschenthal's rise to the top of the hill.
