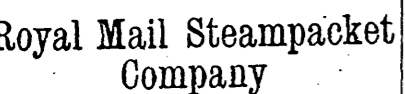

These sneers will find no echo in Brazil, because the nation really wishes peace with La Plata and all the world.

But the amiable dilettant to whom the interests of the British have been handed over, is not a man of the same caliber.
