This latter condition has been complied with by the investment of the money in the purchase of land at Cañadon, with wooden houses suitable for the reception of fever patients.

Besides the above Fever Fund, the funds of the last Bazaar Fund, the funds of the last Bazaar Fund, were at the same time jointly invested in the same important purchase, which comprises about 7 1/2 squares of land, formerly the property of Mr. Fraser and Mr. Bell, the total amount invested being \$791,444.

The subscribers are aware that during the last great epidemic the Hospital was closed by order of the Municipality, who would not allow fever cases to be taken to that locality; so that, just at a time when the British community most required its assistance, the institution became useless.

The Committee were naturally anxious to be prevented the null benefits of the Hospital from being frustrated in case of the recurrence of a similar difficulty, and the receipt of the above-mentioned munificent donation from the Relief Committee made it absolutely incumbent on them to take decisive measures to this effect.

A Sub-Committee was therefore appointed to devote its attention to the employment of the above Fever Fund; and the same Sub-Committee was also instructed to consider the expediency of selling the present Hospital and ground, and obtaining cheaper land elsewhere on which to place a building more suitable for a hospital.
