Merchants who want to know what is going on about a study well the monthly English board of trade returns; they show at a glance how the trade of the world goes; the following we received for Douro; the returns are for March 1873: "The Board of Trade" returns for the past month show the declared value of our exports to have been £21,742,213, an increase of £1,578,645, or 7 1/2 per cent. on the corresponding month of last year, and of 6 per cent. on that of 1872—a difference which probably represents simply the advance in the cost of raw material and labour. Thus in the case of cotton, which in the increase is shown of nearly 61 per cent. in the value of our shipments, there has been a falling off of more than 11 per cent. in their quantity. In the exportation of iron also there has been a fractional decrease in quantity, concurrently with an increase of 35 per cent. in the declared value. In the other branches of trade there have been no special features, with the exception that the cotton-wool of industry is causing on the Continent an extraordinary demand for machinery of all kinds, so that an augmentation of about 43 per cent. is shown in the present return. The woolen business has been slack, and figures for a falling off of about 16 per cent., but in nearly all other classes of manufacture an increase is exhibited. In cotton piece goods it has been 8 per cent. in quantity and 6 per cent. in value, in earthenware 28 per cent. in value, in haberdashery 3 per cent., in hardware 14 per cent., and in linen piece goods 3 per cent. Silk manufactures show a falling off of 14 per cent., as regards the importations of the month, it appears that the arrivals of cotton, have been 1,418,929 cwt., valued at £6,236,216, against 1,206,155 cwt., valued at £5,262,648, in the corresponding month of last year; and that of wheat they have been 2,820,809 cwt., valued at £1,617,951, against 2,777,964 cwt., valued at £1,617,951. Of flour the imports have been 646,971 cwt., valued at £206,736, against 655,610 cwt., valued at £222,845, the increase being consequent on large arrivals from France. Of grain other than wheat the value imported has been 21,411,720, against 1,661,787 in the corresponding month of last year.

We notice that within the last few days the Argentine Government took about £120,000 sterling in exchange; the rate is not given, but the Treasury paid for the bills 69,870 1/2. The admirable secrecy with which the Government brooked the debt is most commendable, particularly when the bills were taken in a rising scale, and the business was done at a profit of 4 to 5 per cent. under the current market rate, without people knowing it; but in transactions of such importance the quiet and quiet done the better. Few, very few of our exchange brokers have the required reticence of countenance to take £120,000 at one pull and still seem hungry for a commission. Messrs. J. C.
