The week has closed upon our dear old night money market; a lower rate for stocks, a slightly diminished bullion reserve, an inflated Cedula speculation, and a rather cloudy political horizon. The October coupon which falls due on Wednesday may to a certain extent mitigate the effects of the extension and far more threatening than most of the Bolea people imagine, much no doubt depends upon the candour and patriotism of our legislators, for one false step at the moment might involve us in a trouble too serious even for contemplation; but aside from the political difficulties that surround the situation, there are unlooked for monetary troubles that during the winter recess have been silently maturing and which now at the entry of the busy season culminate in what may be aptly termed a 'corner.' To what extent that 'corner' may reach depends less upon our own than upon the extraneous aid in the market in the ensuing month may receive. If, as we have already remarked, no gold from abroad is received in October, then we may look for a rise in our discount rate, which will force a liquidation upon our own resources. This liquidation will begin with the Cedula none can for a moment doubt; the question is not where it will begin, but where it will end. The banks to their cost know well how this new stock has drained them of deposits which in other times they could ever count on; and through the last week the bankers have been making as it were a combined effort against this stock, but the difference between the Bolea quotation of the stock and its value relation with the market interest rate is so severe that if the natural current of the market to the cost to find its own, we may look for numerous and serious failures. On the other hand, this monetary cloud is not without its silver lining, for the new B. Ayres loan may be negotiated in time for the wool season, and many think the first specie remittance will come in the Bolea. Again, the Provincial Bank may possibly ship conditional bonds to England and draw against the amount. The new National Bank, with its new issue of notes in November, must certainly help upon gold from abroad than anything else, and should there be any hitch in the loan, or even a temporary delay, we may look forward to a 24 per cent. rate for money at the very outset of the season, when money for wool purposes must be forthcoming. Were our Legislature composed of merchants and others, who well know the requirements of the market; we might look forward to immediate relief in the shape of a Bank Act authorizing our private banks to emit upon a certain fixed specie basis, but our public men are too long to view to their Provincial Bank monopoly to see the matter in a broad or comprehensive light: the great expansion going on is unknown to them. They have created a new stock, but failed to provide us with new funds for that stock. The result is that our private banks—our, and even the Provincial Bank—are getting drained of deposits. Ten millions of patacones are absorbed by that new stock; the money is now required for the legitimate trade of the country, and every one asks—where is it to come from?

Even the sale of the Mendez Tramway has been felt in this market, and the operations during the week in connection with this matter have shown themselves in our exchange market; and helped very many parties who have had large sums locked up in the business. There are still one or two concerns in this market that of right should be worked on cheap foreign capital, and which to a certain extent are a weight on this money market: the probabilities are that they will be relieved of this weight in a few months as they will, like the Mendez Tramway, be passed in London. Could we in like manner move out our Cedula, it would be well indeed for the country; but we suppose there is a hitch somewhere which renders the thing impossible. So long as the demands on our money market were limited to wool, hides, beef and tallow, we had enough for every thing; but the native tramway companies, telegraphs, railways, gas companies, Cedula, land sales, and what not, have proved altogether too many and too much for the market—and the sooner we dispost of all these native enterprises, started without capital, and worked without credit, the better.

A sale of Gas shares at 80 prem.—that is to say, 1800 m/c per share—is reported, and for a good round lot. The stock, it seems has stiffened for this sale has been effected since the sale at 40, or 1400 m/c per share, which caused such a panic. It appears now that holders are unwilling to sell at such low rates, and buyers are offering.

It was said to-day that on a reconsideration of the application for Cedula, by a well-known company, one of the board was of opinion that 20,000 patacones ought to be advanced, but the majority of the board opined that 100,000 was quite enough to advance, a sum which is of course rejected by the applicant.

The Santa Fe Mortgage Bank concession, which we publish in another column, is a very important matter, and will, we believe, be placed in the London market. The business in good hands might be made a very splendid affair, as the privileges are valuable, and there is very ample room for the safe and sound working of such a concern in Rosario, the second city of the Republic.

Mr. Hargreaves, who has just arrived from England, has inspected the new National Bonds, and reports them to be very nice and in every respect as those selling on the London Stock Exchange, with the single exception that those in London have the name of Sterns Brothers stamped in the corner. It is a coincidence that the last large order from England for National Bonds came from Messrs. Sterns Brothers, who, doubtless, buy here to sell in London.

Our articles from Montevideo are as follows:—The sales in Douda Interna were on a large scale to-day, as it is drawing near the close of the month. In the ring nearly 500,000 chingoldo hands, mostly at 61 per cent. Towards the close prices stiffened, and sellers obtained 61 1/2 and 63 for end of October. Exchange—Commercial paper done at 61d. A small amount of Bank done at 51/4. Takers at former rate. Very few drawers. On France business transacted at 5.42 to 5.45. On Antwerp, 5.42. Mr. F. S. Waldon, the new manager of the London and River Plate Bank, was welcomed by his numerous friends on 'Change to-day; on the 1st prox. he takes charge of the bank. The news of the safety of the Patagonia and Potosi has caused much satisfaction here. The ss. Ebro left for you yesterday, but the Post Office here did not notify her departure, consequently most people were unable to send letters by her. The failure of a barraqueiro is spoken of—name not yet transpired.

There was an early attendance on 'Change to-day as the question was not money or discount rates, but the secret session; after a word of exertion it was discovered that the whole business is about Mr. Senator Oroño and his imp. account.

The John Elder is likely to bring full details as the American mail was entering Rio as the Ebro left. It is to be true that 80 vessels are lost, it should make a terrible impression on the lumber market here.

Mr. Crawford, the representative in the River Plate of Messrs. Waring Bros of London arrived to-day morning, and was welcomed on 'Change. The hull of the wrecked barque Mangot at the mouth of the bay of Montevideo, was sold for 200 patacos; the Port Captain has placed certain conditions on the removal of things from the wreck. Mr. M. Fetti, a well known French merchant of Montevideo, is expected back from Europe next month, the Oriental steamer Rayo has been re-manned and manned, and sent up the Uruguay.
