If there be anything to regret, it is the exclusive privilege for twenty years, and the concession allowed to the bank for the emission of scrip with or without interest; but these concessions, which 'a priori' seem to be condemned, can, we think, satisfactorily explained.

The Legislature of Santa Fe desired the establishment of such a bank in its province as quickly as possible, feeling the importance of this institution for the general interests; and it is natural that it should allow such large concessions, in order to secure the bank's establishment in that province. Besides, we must agree that the only way of attracting capitals is, the offer of higher profits than they get in the other centres where they are in circulation.

The concession of the Rosario Mortgage Bank will not only secure great benefits to the public, but also to the province, as it will increase its wealth, which must be very satisfactory for those who desire the progress of this country.
