THE PROVINCIAL BANK. ITS RISE AND PROGRESS.

(By Dr. Octavio Garrigos.) For fifty years the Provincial Bank was the only one that could emit paper

Mr. Courcelle, in his treatise on Banks, alludes to those of Rio Janeiro and Buenos Ayres as injurious by reabeing soon converted into manufactories of paper money. "That of Buenos Ayres was founded in 1822, with a capital of one million dollars, and was absorbed only two years later, beginning to emit unredeemable paper-money, of which the emission exceeded 210 millions in 1856."

The capital of one million was in shares of \$1000 each, part paid-up in gold and part in the Bank's own notes. In 1823 the emission was \$1,800,000, and the paid up capital barely one. fitth. Meantime the troops in the Provinces had to be paid in specie, and when an army was sent to the Uruguay against Brazi, in 1825, a branch Bank was opened in Entre Rios for paying the troops in paper. Meantime the gold of the Bank tell to zero, and the holders of notes became so uneasy that on January 7th, 1826, Deputy Aguero's bill was adopted by Congress, whereby the Bank of Discounts was transformed into a National Bank and its notes guaranteed by Government, the emission then amounting to \$2,694,856, and the notes being at a discount of 12 per cent., say 18 to the doubloon, or 44 pence to the dollar.

In fact the difficulties were so thick that in May 1826 the Congress passed a law of Forced-currency, making the notes legal tender, and obliging the Bank to pay one-third in bar-silver. No wonder that the notes fell in the very same year to less than 16 pence English, being 57 to the doubloon. The Government sent a note to the Directors in angry terms, saying that the evil proceeded from extended credits, and enclosing a decree whereby nobody was to get more than \$80,000 out of the Bank, and ordering all over that sum to refund at once. The real tault was that the Government had drawn 9,422,555\$, while the subscriptions received from the public did not
