ALARMING RUMORS.

The good city of Buenos Ayres is periodically frightened out of its propriety by extravagant rumors that happily prove to be mere summer clouds passing over the surface of our usually clear horizon.

These rumors, it must be confessed, have always a color of truth, besides antecedents in our history to give substance and substance to gloomy apprehensions.

The present agitation of Alsinistas and Cidistas reminds us of the Crudos and Cidistas, some ten years ago, when the city seemed destined to see its streets flow with the blood of rival factions.

As for the possibility of a war between B. Ayres and Brazil we should be slow to believe it. The advance that Brazil is making in the arts of peace would indicate the reverse of an intention to plunge the Empire in war.

Newspapers are not always the best friends of peace; and it is to be regretted that both the Brazilian and Argentine journalists have for some time displayed an angry temper, instead of throwing oil upon the troubled waters.

In all probability we should have fewer alarming rumors if we had not so many newspapers. Twenty-six editors writing every day must naturally choose something piquant for their subject, as the same old-horse theme of politics wears even the most patient readers.

THE ITALIAN BANK.

Banking is a fine business in most countries, and especially in B. Ayres. From time to time we have to report handsome dividends, year after year, from everyone of the Banks in our city.

The paid-up capital is small, only £300,000 sterling, while the cash movement for the last half-year has reached 8 millions sterling.

The chief study of the Directors has been to establish the credit of the bank on a firm basis, and the above results are therefore most satisfactory.

Then follows a comparative statement of the various items of business for the first and second half-years of 1873, which we may conclude thus (reducing currency to specie)...

MAGELLAN COAL-FIELDS.

The latest advices from Sandy Point show renewed activity in the coal-fields adjacent to that settlement, and the following letter throws so much light upon the subject that it will be read with some degree of interest.

"Hitherto the only ambition of the Magellan Coal Co. has been to supply passing steamers, but now they have hopes of opening up markets at Buenos Ayres and Montevideo to supply the various gas companies."

"We want a larger supply of workmen, so as to keep 4 locomotives going, instead of two, and a good number of lighters at the point of shipment. We cannot make any contracts for B. Ayres or Montevideo until we get more workmen and rolling-stock."

"I return to Sandy Point on the 6th inst to begin a new mode of working, thus—Each train of 20 or 30 waggons, drawn by a locomotive, to take 60 or 80 tons of coal from the mouth of the pit to the pier for loading the lighters, which latter will then be towed by a small steamer we have got for the purpose, so as to get alongside the ocean steamers that want our coal."

"The Denis Affre is the same vessel that we sent down last month with rails for continuing the line of railway to the coal-field. We shall be in a position to make contracts for one or two years, delivering the coal on board at Sandy Point, and lending our men to stow it for a small extra charge."

"We are actually making a contract with one of the ocean steam-lines for supplying 800 tons a month, and said company pressed us hard to make it 1000 tons monthly, but we were afraid to undertake so heavy a contract until we got everything in improved trim."

"The moment I arrive at Sandy Point I have not only to push forward the company's plans in this respect, but also to look after and provide for the new hands that arrived per Luxor."

Yours very faithfully, EDITOR'S TABLE. The heaviest deluge of rain (for the short time it lasted) that ever fell in Buenos Ayres came down yesterday morning.

The stock was as you may readily understand first class, and whether cattle, or sheep, was always kept up to the same high standard by the judicious periodical introduction of new blood.

The stocks of horses and mares were cross bred (or mestizo) and the majority of a heavy description 'Clydesdales,' excellent draught horses; of course there were sufficient inares of a lighter class for the general work of cattle and for the overseers, &c.

The homestead was unique, and in so short a period as seven years the signs of Anglo-Saxon energy and steady perseverance were visible on all sides.

"I believe I have mentioned all that will most interest your readers excepting the school. This was carried on in a room adjoining the overseer's cottage, but since then I have reasons to know that one or two churches with their schools in combination have been built on the estate; up to that time Divine Service was held in the large dining room of the Family residence."

"The change of gauge on the 3rd and 4th of October last from the 4 1/2 ft. gauge to the 4 ft. 8 1/2 in. gauge on a length of 421 miles between Stratford and Montreal had been satisfactorily accomplished by 1,500 men."

"The Montezuma brought out 800 emigrants, all first rate bone and sinew, most of it Ligurian. They were landed on Friday. There was a mild row on board on Thursday owing to bread running short, but the agents quickly sent off a supply from shore, which made things pleasant at once."

"The wall of complaint from the Baracas Fomento shareholders is rising higher and higher. We had further enquiries yesterday as to why a meeting is not called. Are there no Directors or Managers to answer the question?"

"The aduana nueva in Calle Florida is now being used again. Goods are being deposited there. Duelling is the order of the day here and at the Mount. Two engineers named Simon and Thibaut went out there last week at early dawn, and exchanged two pistol shots each. There may have been bullets in the weapons; but unless these gentlemen go out again, and one of them, at least, be winged, not a man on either side of the Plate will believe it (if even then) whatever the women and children may think."

"The estancieros of Tapalquen are in a nice predicament just now. The Indians are on them, and have relieved them of many a good troop of horses. On the other hand, the 'powers that be' call on them for all their horses to assist in repelling the savages. The latest accounts represent General Rivar as having arrived at Blancos Grande. He has a few officers and men wounded, but the rumour of the massacre of 400 National Guards was a 'bola' of the first water."



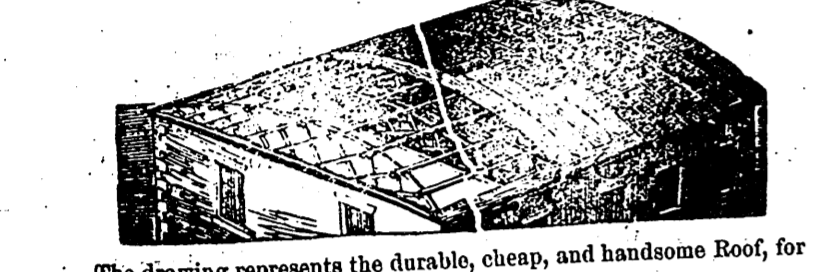
