An Alderman remarked that the Ethiopian was an Oriental (what an atrocious insult!) and had no right to 'reclamar.' A couple of Town Councilors gave the Alderman the lie oblique, and said the nigger was an Argentine citizen.

Words waxed warm, and finally the 'Junta' adjourned to the corridor 'to have it out.' Here a scuffling, scratching and howling melee ensued, chairs, spittoons, sticks, hats, boots, bottles and umbrellas flying about like hailstones.
