An American gentleman has favored us with the following, which will doubtless interest ostentatious and cat's paw dealers—'Utica, N.Y.—The Eighth Duchess of Geneva, better known as the 450,000 cow, died at the farm of Samuel Campbell, New York Mills, on Friday.

The Eighth Duchess of Geneva was a red and white cow, by Third Lord Oxford, and was calved on July 28, 1865. At the sale of Mr. Campbell's stock at New York Mills, on the 10th of September, 1873, she was, after some little excitement, knocked down to a Mr. Davis for the sum of 40,000 dollars, who was buying for a well known English breeder, but having exceeded his limit by some 10,000 dollars, an arrangement was made by which the sale was cancelled, and it was subsequently announced that Colonel Morris, of Westchester County, had either purchased the cow outright, or a share in her.

We are indebted to Mr. Fred. Powell, purser of the Minho, for our regular files of English papers outside of the mail, and the following log notes—Argentine ships of war Uruguay and Parana left St. Vincent, Cape Verde, for the River Plate, on the 6th of June. S.S. Seine, Hibernia and Edinburg, were at St. Vincent, with Brazil cable on board, awaiting arrival of Investigator.

Douro left St. Vincent on the 6th of June. Nova arrived at Rio on the 19th do. Minho arrived at Rio on the 16th of June, and was detained there till the afternoon of the 19th, having a very heavy cargo for that port. The steamer brought down from San Pedro all the auctioneers: people from the great estate auction held up there on the 23rd instant. Owing to the great scarcity of horses in the camp the attendance was not over large; about 60 present.

The estancia, one of the finest in the country, on the arroyo Espinillo, with an area of a little over a square league, 37,280,000 square varas, sold for \$1,125,000 m/c; Don Emilio Castro, whose estancia adjoins, purchaser. This was a trifle under the valuation, which was 1,562,272 m/c. The sheep sold at from 27 to 37; the mares, 90 to 110; horned cattle nearly all gone; nothing to offer. The whole sale realized over the two-third valuation, \$2,600,000 m/c, quite a large sum for estancia property at the moment.
