Today is the Independence Day of Chile, the republic of all others in South America which has shown itself best entitled to the blessings of self-government.

During an interval of sixty years Chile has had the good fortune to be comparatively exempt from local dissensions or despotic rule.

During an interval of sixty years Chile has had the good fortune to be comparatively exempt from local dissensions or despotic rule.

Whatever Chile has she owes it to herself, while the Argentine Republic is not strictly a South American community, but a cosmopolitan mixture of many nations gradually blending into a coherent and highly enterprising commonwealth.

Chile has the indisputable honor of having started the first railway in South America, and the first line of steamers.

No wonder that the name of Chile is cordially received in all foreign countries, and her Bonds in the London Stock-exchange stand before those of any other republic except the U. States.

The total trade of Chile averages £14 millions sterling, that of the Argentine Republic £21 millions.

Thus we see these two countries progressing steadily in the course marked out for them by the genius of the 19th century.

While we are every moment expecting the prolonged section from Chascomus to Dolores to be opened to public traffic it is pleasant to observe that the Company are about commencing two important branches, which will traverse some of the finest districts in the Province, and bring a great increase of traffic to the railway.

Under date September 24th, 1874, (which should be August 24th), the official journal of yesterday publishes a report by Messrs. Salas, Kahr and Arrufio, of the Topographic Department, upon the plans and surveys submitted by Mr. Krabbe, Resident Director, of the proposed branch from Temperley to Cañuelas and Monte, and the prolongation of the Salado branch from Carmen Las Flores as far as Azul.

As regards the first it is proposed to move the Temperley station 200 yards, to which the Government engineers offer no objection, but the route marked by Mr. Krabbe proceeds for the first mile and a half through streets already opened or about to be opened, which is contrary to the general Railway Law of November, 1871.

Meantime the neighbors and Municipality of Lomas earnestly petition the Governor to overrule any technical difficulty, and approve the route of Mr. Krabbe.

Considerable difficulty existed about fixing the site of the station at Azul, the Municipality wishing to place it on the wrong side of the river, while the railway company accepted the donation of a convenient site close to the town.

As the people of Honduras living on the frontiers, are threatened with famine, the Government of Nicaragua has permitted the exportation of maize across the frontiers in quantities not above ten quintals.
