CONGRESS OF 1874. The Congress of 1873 was one of new railways; that of 1874 has been one of repose.

October: Budget and Customs law for the year 1875. The Sarmiento Administration wished to leave a graceful record to the city of B. Ayres in endowing it with the so-called needed People's Park.

The election of President and Vice-President of the Republic no doubt occupied in a great measure the attention of Congress, explaining why the session has been otherwise more or less devoid of interest.

The declaration of the whole Republic in a state of siege was a measure that could hardly be avoided, in view of the revolution, at the same time that it is calculated to cause an uneasy feeling in those countries connected with us by trade relations.

THE SITUATION. TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY. Congress closed yesterday, the Senate having passed a note to the National Government to the effect that it would be better to defer till next year the bills proposing to make Dr. Sarmiento a General, and Dr. Alvear Minister to London.

The Government organs give the following account of the Southern army which Col. Julio Campos conducted to Chascomus by rail: it has been reinforced by the Provincial battalion under Col. Garmendia, who now takes command of the whole division.

An English estanciaero just arrived from the Salado says Gen. Rivas was encamped last week near 25 de Mayo. Two of his men robbed a house, the owner of which at once rode up to the General, and the two offenders were shot, right off.

The Sarmiento Administration wished to leave a graceful record to the city of B. Ayres in endowing it with the so-called needed People's Park, and as Palermo is within easy reach of the city by rail or road the site is well chosen.

The Government papers reproduce the Bulletin of the Revolution as follows: "The fact of two deserters from Gen. Arredondo's army passing over to Col. Roca has been magnified into a whole regiment. Hence the belling and rockets."

"General Rivas, with 2,400 troops of the line and 6,500 National Guards, is encamped near Keen's estancia, some three leagues from Chivilcoy: this is the left wing.

"The Mitrists have changed 27 Justices of the Peace, in the South and West, without spilling a drop of blood. Rivas has sent a force to the North, to change the Judges up there, about Pergamino.

The admission of Argentines and even of all Europe, has been trampled on, and the rights of freemen turned into a jest. Patience could stand it no longer, and now all the provinces of the Republic have risen up with arms in their hands to vindicate the Constitution by removing a scandal caused by a few misguided men who make the city their headquarters.

National Guards of the Sol de Mayo! I also bid you take up arms; I am your comrade, commander, and friend, whose sword has always been on the side of law and order, and under whom you have invariably marched to victory.

The term of D. Domingo Faustino Sarmiento's administration having expired I have the honor to advise Your Majesty that I have been raised to the Chief Magistracy of the Argentine Republic by the votes of my countrymen, and that I have assumed power on the 12th inst. in presence of Congress.

An alarm occurred in town on Monday night, the Government having received a telegram that the gunboat Parana and four other steamers were off Punta Lara. The last train from Ensenada did not arrive, and the telegraph wires were cut.

The Mitrists have added the steamer Montevideo and two other vessels to the Parana. The Montevideo mounts 6 guns of 18 and 24 pound calibre, under command of Captain Magnasco, with Vasquez and Usher. The Parana passed Montevideo on Sunday, and the Montevideo was off the Cerro same evening, with arms, boarding ladders &c.
