4th Money is received in ac-

count current bearing interest due

of deposit which is paid quarterly

any time by means of cheques

or bills of exchange, and the

amount which the quantity exceeds

three hundred dollars or one

hundred thousand dollars pre-

mium is to be given at the

Treasury of the Bank.

5th Bills of exchange, credits or

deposits, payable on demand, or

in three months, in Argentina and

Spain, payable to us, or to any

agent of ours, or to any person

having a right to receive payment

from us, or to any other person de-

posited to the credit of us.

6th Current Accounts.

Which will be opened under the fol-

lowing conditions:

1st. Funds deposited in Current

Account will be subject to the rate of

interest on Current Account.

2d. Interest on Current Account

will be capitalized every three months.

3d. Cheques against deposits in

Current Account will be free of all charge
